

Tips for Writing Holiday Greeting Cards in English

1. Find a writing buddy

Bounce ideas off of each other and proofread each other's messages before sending.

2. Remember to be sensitive to people's beliefs

If you're not sure if someone celebrates Christmas, choose a neutral greeting like "Happy Holidays" or "Season's Greetings."

3. Keep it brief

Avoid adding personal details when writing to coworkers and clients.

4. Consider adding an adjective

Make your message more personable by adding an adjective. If your friend loves food, you could say, "Wishing you a delicious holiday season!"

5. Choose an appropriate closing

End your message with "Love," or "With love," for family and friends and "Best wishes," or "Warm regards," for colleagues and clients.
